DENVER River Great Ouse PE38 0EQ

Denver Sluice is an important site for water management across large parts of the Cambridgeshire Fens, located at the confluence of five watercourses. Denver lock provides navigation access on to the tidal Great Ouse with passage to Salters Lode or on to Kings Lynn for access out to sea.

Facilities on site at Denver include a waterpoint, slipway, pump out, elsan point, car parking, CCTV and a picnic area. The Jenyns Arms pub and West Norfolk Rowing Club are both located at Denver Complex too.

Mooring type	West Bank – Online fixed mooring platforms. Leisure Use (non-residential). East Bank - Online fixed mooring platforms and rise and fall finger pontoons. Leisure Use (non-residential)
Facilities	Water, General rubbish bins, Pump Out, Elsan, Slipway, Picnic area, toilets (opening late 2020)
Berth sizes	Various - maximum 37ft/ 11.30m

Parking	Free car park on West Bank and small parking area next to East Bank moorings.
Security	The moorings are covered by CCTV. The East Bank moorings are accessed via a padlocked gate.
Mooring duration	Minimum 16 weeks, no maximum. Moorings are renewed annually.
Visitor moorings	EA 48hr mooring West Bank.
Mooring Fees	2020-21 season West Bank £85.20 per metre per year inc VAT; East Bank £106.80 per metre per year inc VAT
