UPWARE Reach Lode CB7 5ZR

Upware leisure moorings are part of the Cambridgeshire Lodes and is located within Upware village.

The mooring site is situated in a rural location between Ely and Cambridge, surrounded by open countryside, with three Sites of Special Scientific Interest close by. It has far reaching views across the local countryside, thanks to its unique characteristic of being elevated above ground level.

Access by boat to these moorings are through Upware lock off the River Cam.

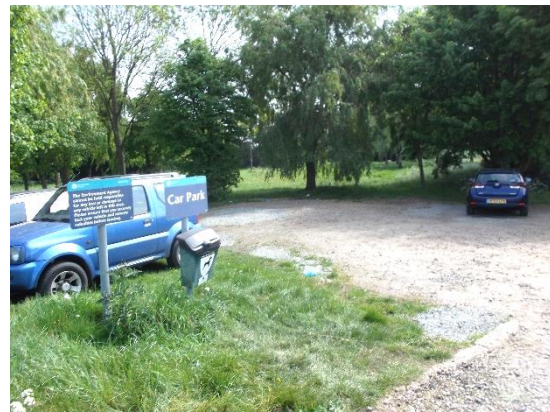
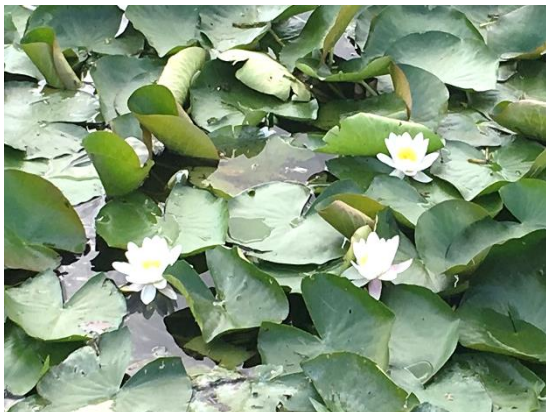

Mooring type	Online Leisure Use (non-residential)
Facilities	Drinking water, general waste bins.
Berth sizes	Maximum 62ft/ 18.90m
Parking	Car parking is available in the nearby 'Fishermans' Car park free of charge. During the summer months vehicles may access the bank for loading and unloading. They must not be left for extended periods or overnight.
Security	There is a locked gate to prevent unauthorised access along the flood bank. There is restricted vehicular access along the bank during the winter months as this is a flood bank. This is to prevent damage while the ground is wet.

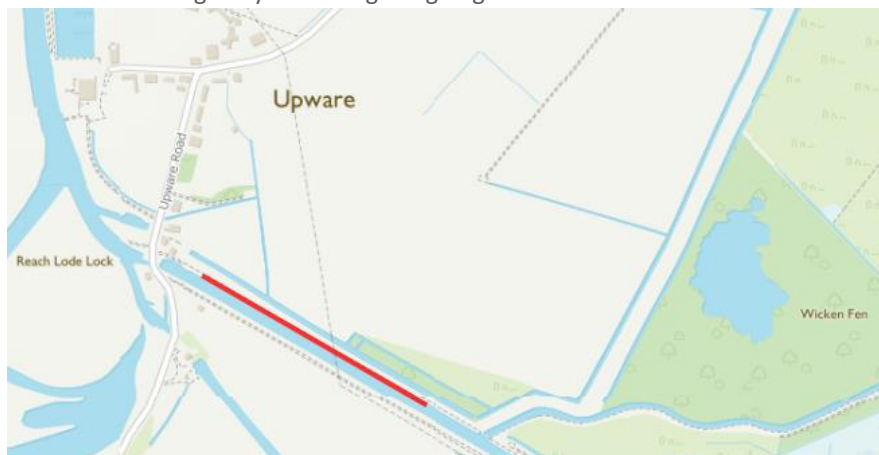

- Visitor moorings EA 48hr mooring at far end near the turning to Wicken Fen.
- Mooring Fees 2019-20 season £104.40 per metre per year inc VAT.
